



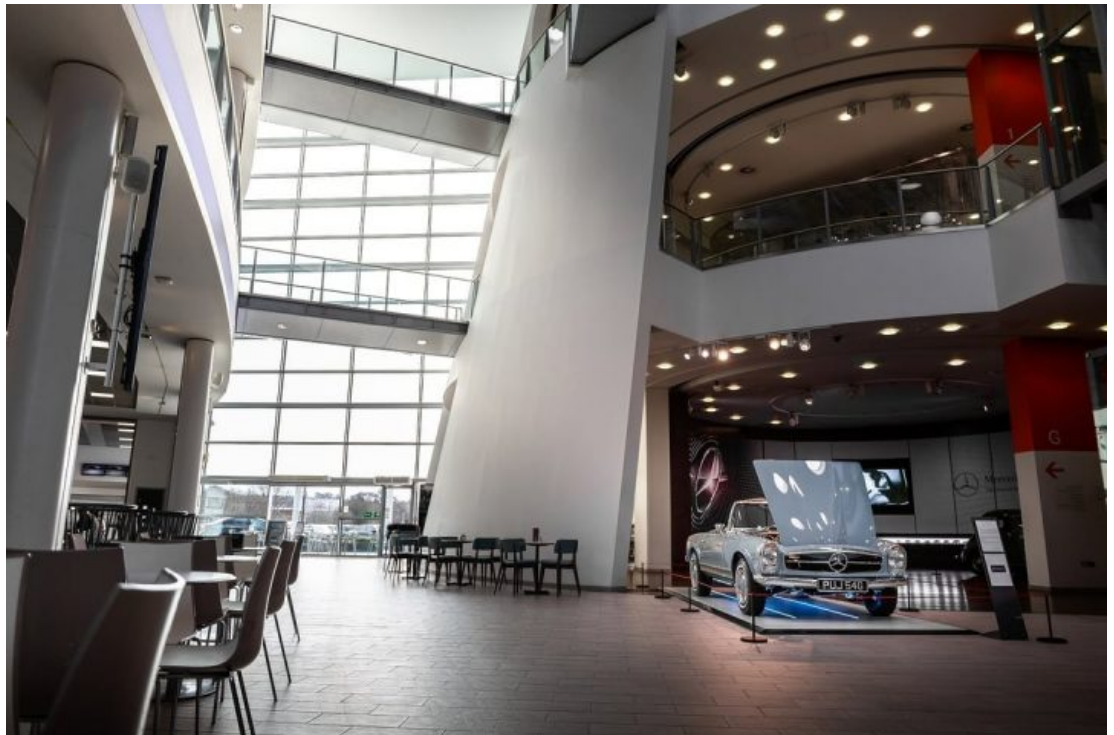
## Classic Mercedes remade in Wales now on show

A remanufactured Mercedes-Benz sports car created in Wales is now taking pride of place in the German manufacturer's leading UK centre.



The hand-built 280SL sports car dates from 1968 and is owned by former racing driver Paul Rees who had it completely stripped, renovated, and rebuilt with a highly polished engine by **Hemmels** of Cardiff.

The massive project took over 4,000 hours by a team of expert restoration specialists in South Wales and it comes with a 12 months warranty, a full leather interior and light blue paint finish.

The cost of the work is in the region of £285,000 and it's currently in the foyer of Mercedes-
