The VW Arteon five-seat coupe is now available to order with a new 272ps 2.0 TSi engine and seven speed automatic transmission.

The flagship 4WD model comes in two trim levels from £39,065 and £39,850.

Only four out of ten UK motorists (41%) would call the Police if they thought a car was being driven by a drunk driver.
