The SEAT Leon Cupra has always closely stuck to a top performance and value per pound ethos and now it is taking the fight to the hot hatch elite with the latest 300PS versions becoming even more tempting through savings of up to £1,945.

The revised pricing applies to all three Leon Cupra 300 bodystyles, Sports Coupé, five-door and Sports Tourer. The Leon SC CUPRA 300 DSG-auto benefits from the largest saving, with £1,945 taken off of its previous price while best-selling five-door and ST are just a smidgen behind losing £1,905 respectively.

The Fiat Tipo range is expanding to include the new S-Design.

Available in hatchback and station wagon versions, the new version is immediately recognisable thanks to its distinctive wide grille with glossy black trim, Bi-Xenon headlights, and diamond cut 18-inch alloy wheels, tinted rear windows and body coloured handles complete the look with a 1.4 T-Jet 120hp petrol engine from £18,145.
