Eight years after it created the compact crossover segment, the one millionth Juke has rolled off the line at Nissan Sunderland Plant.

On average, a Juke is built at the plant every 105 seconds, while three million Qashqai have been built there since 2006.

Ford in America will pay the equivalent of over £226M to settle a civil actions arising from claims of failed or faulty Takata airbags in models.

Honda, Toyota, Nissan, Mazda, Subaru and BMW have already settled with a total of about £900M equivalent to their customers and some 30M US models are affected.

Motorists aged between 25-34 would be the most likely to buy a car via an app according to the results of a survey by HPI.

Only 19% in this age range said they wouldn't consider buying a new car in this way and a quarter (26%) wouldn't consider an app purchase of a used vehicle while for those aged 65 or more, almost three-quarters (71%) would never consider buying a new car online while for used cars the figure is even higher at 76%.

Over six children each month are killed on main roads, according to figures from Highways England and criticised by the road safety body Brake.

It wants more police on roads, tougher enforcement of drink-drive law and a review of speed limits among other changes to make the Government reach its target of 40% fewer serious accidents over the next two years.
