Suzuki GB PLC has been ranked as the best car brand in the Institute of Customer Service's UK Customer Satisfaction Index (UKCSI) for January 2019.

A national measure of sentiment across the country, the research asks 45,000 consumers to rate their experiences of dealing with nearly 260 different companies across 13 sectors, including those in the motor industry.
