The battle for global SUV sales is a neck-and-neck fight between the long established Toyota RAV4 and the rapidly gaining new VW Tiguan.

Under 4,000 units globally separate the two with the German model gaining every month and a long way behind them in third is the best seller of 2016, the Honda CR-V, say Focus2Move analysts.

The new Vauxhall Combo van will start from £15,630 exc VAT.

It features high technology driving and infotainment, a very flexible loading arrangement in petrol or diesel versions and four trim levels in December.

A third of UK fleets now use telematics to monitor their vehicles, say Arval.

The company has been told the main reason trackers are used is to locate vehicles, followed by a driver safety issue and improving driving standards, with running costs being further considerations.
